Dear Mr. Galloway:

On December 18, 2012, the Electric Reliability Council of Texas ("ERCOT") filed in this Project ERCOT's Report concerning Market Participant Non-Compliance with Digital Certificate Annual Audits. GDF SUEZ Retail Energy Solutions LLC DBA Think Energy ("Think Energy") were on the list of Market Participants that had not submitted to ERCOT results of the Market Participant's annual audit of its list of Digital Certificate holders.

Please be advised that Think Energy timely completed Digital Certificate Annual Audits for all digital certificates issued to it, and timely submitted to ERCOT (on September 24, 2012) attestations verifying that the parties had controlled their respective digital certificates and users in compliance with ERCOT Protocols for all Market Participant functions for which ERCOT had issued digital certificates. The Audit report and attestations were under the name of "Think Energy." When ERCOT filed the referenced report listing Think Energy as having not submitted a report, Think Energy discovered that it had inadvertently transmitted its Audit report and affidavit to ERCOT under the name of its affiliate GDF Suez Energy Resources NA, Inc. ("GSERNA"). ERCOT received Think Energy's report at that time and did not notify it that it had used the wrong name, and did not notify GSERNA that GSERNA had seemingly submitted two different Audit reports.

Think Energy then immediately resubmitted its report and affidavits to ERCOT (on December 20, 2012), designating the Audit report and attestations under the correct name. ERCOT has received the Audit report and affidavits. Think Energy has therefore corrected this inadvertent oversight.

Think Energy would note that it did file the required Audit report and attestations on a timely basis, as required by law, and that ERCOT has been in possession of the required information since September 24th. Think Energy simply submitted this information under the name of its affiliate GSERNA.
