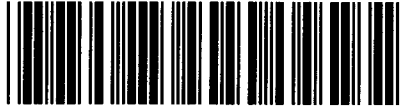

To the Attention of PUC Commissioners and Chairman Nelson

I am supporting the Petition of Devoxy Kidd and John Kidd in their request to terminate the installation of Smart Meters in Texas. The PUC has an obligation to protect both the health and the privacy of its customers. A smart meter jeopardizes both.

The meters are a violation to my right to privacy. In light of the ease at which a third party can access our information, I find the PUC totally irresponsible and unconcerned with the rights or safety of its customers.

A meter installer asked me for access through my gate, misrepresenting himself by stating he was not installing a smart meter. I denied access. My gate now has approximately \$150 of damage due to forced entry. What makes you think you can act against a customer's wishes when: the private road to my house is not a PUC right-of-way; there is a no trespassing sign; I denied entrance; the gate is one half mile from the meter; the gate is locked; the gate and road are my private property. Congress gave you the OK to install smart meters, not the right to force them upon us against our will. I do not want a smart meter installed at my residence.
