**MOTION TO INTERVENE OF
ONCOR ELECTRIC DELIVERY COMPANY LLC**

TO THE HONORABLE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS:

COMES NOW, Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC ("Oncor") and files this Motion to Intervene in the above-captioned docket. In support of its Motion, Oncor would respectfully show the following:

I. STANDING TO INTERVENE

Oncor; CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC; AEP Texas North Company; AEP Texas Central Company; and Texas New Mexico Power Company entered into a Joint Development and Operations Agreement ("JDOA") dated December 31, 2008 which provides for the joint development, operation and maintenance, and use of Smart Meter Texas™ ("SMT").¹ SMT is an interoperable, web-based information system established and maintained by Oncor and the other JDOA member transmission and distribution utilities in accordance with Public Utility Regulatory Act § 39.107 and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 25.130. As a result of its participation in the JDOA, Oncor is a partial owner of SMT.

The Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission") has initiated this contested case proceeding to address outstanding issues related to SMT, requesting that the Commission determine what changes, if any, should be made to the requirements for the

¹ The JDOA requires unanimous approval among each of the parties before certain actions may be taken with respect to SMT, such as the selection of a vendor to design, build, operate and maintain the SMT web portal. Other actions, such as modifications to the agreed upon development and use of the web portal or the hiring of technology consultants for the web portal, require majority approval among the parties to the JDOA.

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continued operation of SMT. Any changes to the requirements of SMT will directly affect Oncor and its ownership and funding of SMT, which it undertakes in conjunction and cooperation with the other parties to the JDOA. Therefore, Oncor has a justiciable interest and standing to intervene in this proceeding.

Oncor's designated legal and business representatives for purposes of this proceeding are:

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
Oncor requests that all documents in this proceeding be served upon its authorized representatives.
