SOAH ORDER NO. 6
GRANTING REQUEST TO FILE FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
TWO DAYS AFTER BRIEFS ARE FILED


On March 5, 2020, the intervenors and the Staff of the Public Commission of Texas filed a request for an additional two days after briefs are filed to file proposed findings of fact (FoFs) and conclusions of law (CoLs) (the Request). According to Order No. 5, Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO) will file proposed FoFs and CoLs with its initial brief, and the other parties will file redlined responses to SWEPCO's proposed FoFs and CoLs with their reply briefs.

On March 6, 2020, SWEPCO filed a response opposing the Request noting that it has prepared its proposed FoFs and CoLs in accordance with Order No. 5 and plans to file them in accordance with that order on March 9, 2020. SWEPCO also states that the Request should have been filed no later than February 28, 2020, and benefits only the parties who will be filing findings and conclusions with their reply briefs.


The undersigned Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) agree in part with SWEPCO's response but conclude that the extension will benefit the ALJs to the extent it may allow the non SWEPCO parties to file agreed redlined responses to SWEPCO's proposed FoFs and CoLs. The Request, therefore, is **GRANTED**. SWEPCO may, at its discretion, file its proposed FoFs and CoLs no later than March 11, 2020.

The other parties shall file their redlined responses no later than March 19, 2020.
