I am writing on behalf of Ring's manufacturing plant located at 841 Railhead Road, Ft Worth TX 76106.

Yesterday afternoon I was made aware of ERCOT's plan to pass on ancillary fees resulting from the weather induced power supply issues the week of Feb. 15.

Ring very much opposes increases in ancillary charges, especially when it is being unfairly applied to the entire month's cycle and not limited to the period when the charged were incurred.

In speaking with Ring's account rep, I understand that even with the PUCT action this afternoon requiring ERCOT to recover ancillary fees from non performing generators, Ring could expect the ancillary charges (if applied to the entire month's kWh usage) being three times the normal monthly bill.

I understand this is a very dynamic and changing situation. Your consideration and guidance would be greatly appreciated.
