INFORMATION

Pursuant to P.U.C. Subst. R. 25.105(d), Dynegy Power Marketing, Inc. ("DYPM"), hereby submits, to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (the "Commission") the following information concerning material changes to information previously provided by Electric Clearinghouse, Inc. ("ECI") in connection with its registration as a Power Marketer in Project No. 14406.

1. Address, Contact Information and Ownership

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") has authorized DYPM to succeed the power marketing business previously conducted by ECI. Attachment A, attached hereto, contains a copy of the Notice of Succession filed by DYPM with the FERC and the subsequent order issued by FERC accepting it. The Commission's registry of power marketers under P.U.C. Subst. R. 25.105 should be revised to reflect this succession.

DYPM is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Dynegy Inc., an Illinois corporation headquartered in Houston, Texas.

2. Affiliates

DYPM hereby provides the following information regarding its affiliated entities participating in the Texas electric market:

Dynegy Energy Marketing, L.P.

Dynegy Energy Marketing, L.P. ("DEM") a Houston, Texas based Delaware limited partnership, is a Commission certified Retail Electric Provider ("REP") and is currently an active REP in the Electric Reliability Counsel of Texas ("ERCOT").

Cogen Lyondell, Inc.

Cogen Lyondell, Inc., ("Cogen Lyondell") owns and operates an approximately 590 MW cogeneration facility located in Harris county Texas. Cogen Lyondell is a Resource Entity in ERCOT and a registered Participating Generating Company ("PGC") with the Texas PUC.

Oyster Creek Limited

Oyster Creek Limited ("Oyster Creek") owns and operates an approximately 424 MW cogeneration facility located in Brazoria County, Texas. Oyster Creek is a Resource Entity in ERCOT and a registered PGC with the Texas PUC.

3. Location of Facility Used to Provide Service

4. Description of the Type of Service Provided

Wholesale sales and purchases of electric energy, power and ancillary services.

5. Copies of FERC Registration Information

Attachment A, attached hereto, contains a copy of the Notice of Succession filed by DYPM with the FERC and the subsequent order issued by FERC accepting it. The Notice of Succession was filed in order to reflect the name change from ECI to DYPM. ECI was previously granted authority to sell wholesale energy at market-based rates by FERC in Docket No. ER94-968.

A copy of FERC's order granting this authority is already on file with the Commission as part of the initial registration materials of ECI.






