Note (a): On April 18, 2006, the Twin Oaks Power Station was sold to Altura Power, LP, an unaffiliated third party, and thus ceased to be an affiliate of Nueces Bay WLE, LP.

Note (b): On July 7, 2006, Coleto Creek Power, LP, the owner of the Coleto Creek Power Station (632 MW), was sold to American National Power, and thus ceased to be an affiliate of Nueces Bay WLE, LP.

Note (c): On December 18, 2006, the La Palma Power Station (249 MW), which was owned by then affiliate La Palma WLE, LP, and the Lon C. Hill Power Station (553 MW), which was owned by then affiliate Lon C. Hill, LP, were permanently retired.

Note (d): On December 19, 2006, J.L. Bates, LP, the owner of the J. L. Bates Power Station (182 MW), and Victoria WLE, LP, the owner of the Victoria Power Station (492 MW), were sold to NuCoastal Power Corporation, and thus ceased to be affiliates of Nueces Bay WLE, LP.
