CITY PUBLIC SERVICE OF SAN ANTONIO'S REPLY TO INITIAL COMMENTS SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO ORDER No. 13

City Public Service of San Antonio ("San Antonio") files these comments in reply to the initial comments submitted by the Office of Public Utility Counsel ("OPC") and the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("PUCT Staff") pursuant to Order No. 13.

In its comments, OPC recommends that ERCOT be allowed to enter into long-term contracts with load and generation to provide ancillary services. This proposal has significant financial implications for all market participants and these implications have not been subjected to review in this docket. Therefore, San Antonio submits that this issue is beyond the scope of this proceeding and, to the extent the Commission wishes to address this issue, it should do so in a separate proceeding.

The PUCT Staff in its comments proposes that the offer cap expiration date of July 4, 2003 approved by the Commission in Docket No. 23220 be repealed by the Commission in this proceeding. This proposal, having been raised for the first time in the PUCT Staff's comments in response to Order No. 13, is also beyond the scope of issues before the Commission in this proceeding, and should be addressed in a separate proceeding should the Commission desire to do so.
