# RELIANT RESOURCES, INC.'S REQUEST TO FILE LATE

#### AND STATEMENT OF POSITION

On April 25, 2002, the ALJ issued Order No. 1 in the above-captioned Docket. Reliant Resources, Inc. (RRI) inadvertently did not file a statement of position on May 3, 2002. RRI respectfully requests the ALJ accept this late-filed statement of position and requests that it be included in the record in this case. RRI submits that no party is disadvantaged by the filing of this statement of position on May 7,2002. RRI does not plan on filing any direct testimony and takes no issue with TXU Energy Retail Company's (TXU's) filing. RRI wants to assure, however, that its right to cross-examine witnesses and participate fully as a party in the case is preserved.

RRI submits that the proceeding should be limited to (1) the calculation of the average of the closing forward 12-month NYMEX Henry Hub natural gas price, as reported in the *Wall Street Journal*, for each business day of the ten-day period ending no more than ten business days before the filing of the application; (2) whether the calculation of the ten-day rolling price is based on the average forward price for each of the business days; (3) whether the percentage difference between the average ten-day rolling price calculated above and the averaged ten-day rolling price used to calculate the current fuel factor is 4% or more; and (4) whether the amount resulting from the percentage difference is added to one and then multiplied by the current fuel factor.

Based on the foregoing, RRI respectfully requests that the ALJ include RRI's statement of position in the record of this proceeding.
