ORDER NO. 6  
CANCELING STATUS CONFERENCE AND  
PROVIDING INSTRUCTIONS FOR AN AGREED PROPOSED ORDER

On Thursday, September 26, 2002, Applicant filed a Notice of Stipulation and Settlement Agreement, moved that the case be returned to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) for proposed order processing, and moved that the September 30, 2002 status conference set in Order No. 5 now be canceled.


The status conference is canceled as requested. The Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) will return this settled case to the Commission for final processing as soon as the parties supply the ALJ with the remaining filings required by the Commission for settled cases. A complete list of required filings appears below.

- Joint agreed proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs in hard copy and on disk formatted in Microsoft Word for the Commission;
- Copies of all evidence supporting the stipulation (if the supporting evidence has previously been filed, the parties need not re-file it, but must provide a list that clearly identifies the supporting evidence already in the court file so the ALJ can admit it); and
- The regulatory or jurisdictional deadline. If the parties intend to request entry of a Final Order by a particular date, they should so indicate in their submissions to the ALJ.

As soon as the parties file any remaining information, the ALJ will send the hard and electronic copies to the Commission with her order addressing settlement of the contested issues,

the regulatory or jurisdictional deadline, the evidence admitted, and the disposition of the proceeding before the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
