ORDER NO. 8

RESPONDING TO STAFF'S REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION

On June 28, 2002, Guadalupe Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. (GVEC) filed an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity for a proposed 138 kV transmission line in Guadalupe County, Texas.

Motion to Intervene. On October 4, 2002, Order No. 7 was filed to allow Mr. Christopher A. Parker, potential intervenor, until October 11, 2002 to file documentation verifying that he is trustee of the current owner's estate and is authorized to act as agent for the current owner as stated in his motion to intervene.

Request for Clarification. On October 7, 2002, Commission Staff subsequently filed a request for clarification of Order No. 7 as to whether the ALJ intends to modify the procedural schedule to allow Mr. Parker time to request a hearing, if he is granted intervenor status, since the deadline for requests for hearing to SOAH was October 7, 2002.

Procedural Schedule. Once the ALJ rules on Mr. Parker's intervention, the ALJ will evaluate the procedural schedule and will issue an order addressing any modifications to the schedule.
