ORDER NO. 13  
UNABATING AND DISMISSING PROCEEDING

On May 29, 2003, Frontera Generation Limited Partnership (Frontera) filed a withdrawal of the above styled and numbered proceeding. Frontera stated that it had diligently worked with Commission Staff (Staff), the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT), and ERCOT stakeholders over the last several months to put into place a compensatory mechanism for the payment of Out of Merit Capacity (OOMC) service. Frontera stated that those efforts, along with the effective participation and facilitation of the process by Staff, culminated the adoption of PRR 371 by the ERCOT Board. PRR 371 revises the compensation mechanism for generators providing OOMC service for the benefit of the ERCOT market, the purpose for which Frontera initiated this docket.

P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.181(b) allows a party that initiated a proceeding to withdraw its application at any time before that party has presented its direct case. Consistent with the above representations, this docket is hereby unabated for further processing and dismissed pursuant to P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.181(b).
