In 1999 the Texas Legislature enacted provisions in Senate Bill 560 (SB 560), Act of May 30, 1999, 76th Legislature, Regular Session, chapter 1212, 1999 Texas Session Law Service 4210, 4215 (Vernon) (codified as an amendment to the Public Utility Regulatory Act (PURA), Texas Utilities Code Annotated §52.256(b)) requiring telecommunications utilities to file five-year plans to enhance workforce diversity and to file annual reports beginning next calendar year on the status of those plans. Specifically, PURA § 52.256(b) required telecommunications utilities to file, before January 1, 2000, a comprehensive five-year plan to enhance the diversity of their workforces in all occupational categories and to increase their small and historically underutilized businesses contracting. The plan was to include: performance with regard to workforce diversity and contracting; initiatives the utility would pursue in these areas over the next five years; programs and activities the utility would undertake to achieve these initiatives; and a listing of business partnerships the utility would form to facilitate improvement in these areas.

The Public Utility Commission (PUC) staff has set up control numbers in Central Records for utilities to file their annual updates. Accordingly, staff requests telecommunications utilities to file the 2002 annual updates to their five-year plans no later than December 30, 2002, in Project Number 26715, 2002 Annual Progress Reports on Five-Year Plan to Enhance Supplier and Workforce Diversity.
