RE: Tariff Control No. 27424 – *Application of Mutual Energy SWEPCO to Revise Large Power Service Tariff*

NOTICE OF APPROVAL

Background. On September 27 and October 3, 2002, Mutual Energy SWEPCO, LP (ME SWEPCO) filed retail electric provider (REP) certification amendments and revised tariff sheets in compliance with the final Order in Docket No. 25902¹ issued September 17, 2002. In order to facilitate the execution of the assignment of the WTU-SPP customer service obligation as approved in the final Order in Docket No. 25902, the REP certification amendments and revised tariff sheets were approved November 1, 2002 and became effective in the first billing cycle in December 2002.

ME SWEPCO's application to revise tariff. On February 27, 2003, ME SWEPCO filed an application to revise its Large Power Service (LPS) Tariff. The LPS rate schedule was mistakenly omitted from the compliance filing in Docket 25902. On March 24, 2003, as recommended by Staff, ME SWEPCO filed a revised LPS Tariff.

On March 26, 2003, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a recommendation for approval of ME SWEPCO's application to revise its LPS tariff. Consistent with Staff's recommendation, ME SWEPCO's LPS tariff (Sheets 1-3) is approved as revised on March 24, 2003.
