25.43 (q) (1) – For each month of the reporting quarter, the affiliated REP shall report:

(A) The number of residential customers who were disconnected for nonpayment and the number of those customers that were eligible for the rate reduction program under § 25.454 of this title;

July 2004

- CPL Retail Energy disconnected 10,974 residential customers for nonpayment
- 2,709 of those customers were eligible for the rate reduction program

August 2004

- CPL Retail Energy disconnected 10,723 residential customers for nonpayment
- 2,944 of those customers were eligible for the rate reduction program

September 2004

- CPL Retail Energy disconnected 11,825 residential customers for nonpayment
- 3,104 of those customers were eligible for the rate reduction program
- (B) The number of residential customers who were transferred to the affiliated REP by a competitive REP for non-payment and the number of those customers that were eligible for the rate reduction program under § 25.454 of this title;

July 2004

- 1,225 residential customers were transferred to CPL Retail Energy by a competitive REP for non-payment
- 352 of those customers were eligible for the rate reduction program

August 2004

- 689 residential customers were transferred to CPL Retail Energy by a competitive REP for non-payment
- 40 of those customers were eligible for the rate reduction program

September 2004

- 1,317 residential customers were transferred to CPL Retail Energy by a competitive REP for non-payment
- 59 of those customers were eligible for the rate reduction program

(C) The average amount owed to the affiliated REP by residential customers at the time of disconnection;

July 2004

• The average amount owed to CPL Retail Energy by residential customers at the time of disconnection was \$300.43.

August 2004

• The average amount owed to CPL Retail Energy by residential customers at the time of disconnection was \$346.55.

September 2004

- The average amount owed to CPL Retail Energy by residential customers at the time of disconnection was \$374.96.
- (D) The average amount owed to the affiliated REP by residential customers eligible for the rate reduction program at the time of disconnection;

July 2004

• The average amount owed to CPL Retail Energy by residential customers eligible for the rate reduction program at the time of disconnection was \$278.67.

August 2004

• The average amount owed to CPL Retail Energy by residential customers eligible for the rate reduction program at the time of disconnection was \$307.24.

September 2004

- The average amount owed to CPL Retail Energy by residential customers eligible for the rate reduction program at the time of disconnection was \$332.23.
- (E) The number of small non-residential customers who were disconnected for non-payment;

July 2004

 CPL Retail Energy disconnected 821small non-residential customers for non-payment.

August 2004

• CPL Retail Energy disconnected 741 small non-residential customers for non-payment.

September 2004

- CPL Retail Energy disconnected 801 small non-residential customers for non-payment.
- (F) The average amount owed to the affiliated REP by small non-residential customers at the time of disconnection.

July 2004

• The average amount owed to CPL Retail Energy by small non-residential customers at the time of disconnection was \$564.02.

August 2004

• The average amount owed to CPL Retail Energy by small non-residential customers at the time of disconnection was \$668.45.

September 2004
