

NOTICE OF BANKRUPTCY

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND THEIR COUNSEL:

Please be advised that, on May 14, 2003, Allegiance Telecom, Inc. and its subsidiaries, including Allegiance Telecom of Texas, Inc. filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. 101, et. seq. ("Bankruptcy Code"), in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York (case No. 03-13057-rdd). Information concerning the case can be accessed at www.bmccorp.net. Please be further advised that pursuant to Section 362(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, an automatic stay has been imposed, *inter alia*, as to the commencement or continuation, including the issuance or employment of process, of a judicial, administrative, or other action or proceeding against the Defendants that was or could have been commenced before the commencement of the case under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code, or to recover a claim against the Defendants that arose before the commencement of the case under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code, including any action taken to obtain possession of property of the estate or of property from the estate or to exercise control over property of the estate. Any action taken in violation of the automatic stay is void.


