Heavy construction other than buildings such as pipelines, communication and (1) Construction -- Construction done by general contractors and special trade contractors which includes new work, additions, alterations, reconstruction, power lines, sewer and water mains, asphalt and concrete construction of roads, trenching, cable laying, conduit construction, land clearing and leveling. (7) Other – Any commodity or service not covered by the above categories.

# Describe the specific initiatives, programs, and activities undertaken under the plan during the preceding year:

When appropriate, small, local businesses were encouraged to provide quotes for needed services and supplies.

Due to the slow business environment during the year ended September 30, 2003, the company conducted no recruitment.

# Make an assessment of the success of each of the specific initiatives, programs, and activities listed above:

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Due to the slow business environment, the company did not increase its employee count.

The company is currently operating with a core staff of 10 employees and did not engage in any recruitment during the year.

### Describe the initiatives, programs, and activities the utility will pursue during the next year to increase the diversity of its workforce and contracting opportunities for small and historically underutilized businesses:

During the next year, RRV Enterprises, Inc. will continue to welcome applications for employment from qualified individuals of any and all minority groups for any open positions within the company.

RRV Enterprises, Inc. will also continue to solicit offers to furnish goods or services from Small and Historically Underutilized Businesses except where RRV Enterprises, Inc. is bound by contract to purchase goods and services from other sources.

# State the specific progress made under the plan filed by the utility:

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Due to a slowdown in the company's business, no recruitment was conducted during the year. However, the company has continued to maintain contact with its primarily women-owned recruitment firms.

RRV Enterprises, Inc. has also continued to conduct business with its vendors, including small and disadvantaged businesses.
