TO THE HONORABLE ALJ IRENE MONTELONGO:

Entergy Gulf States, Inc. (EGSI) opposes OPC's "Motion to Postpone Stablishment of Procedural Schedule" filed in this docket on January 8, 2004. The Commission has targeted December 2004 for the implementation of retail open access in EGSI's Texas service territory. To achieve that targeted date, this docket should move forward immediately. EGSI will be prepared to state its position on the procedural posture of this docket and other related dockets in more detail at the January 12 prehearing conference.

EGSI, therefore, requests that Your Honor deny OPC's January 8, 2004 "Motion to Postpone Establishment of Procedural Schedule."
