With respect to the status of the Docket 20381 remand since their status report filed last month, San Antonio and CenterPoint would show the Commission as follows:

In the appeal of Docket No. 20381 pending in the Texas Court of Appeals for the Third District at Austin in cause No. 03-02-00701-CV under the style *Texas Municipal Power Agency; City of Denton; City of Garland; and GEUS f/k/a Greenville Electric Utility System, Appellants v. Public Utility Commission of Texas; City of Bryan; and City of Weatherford, Appellees*, on May 20, 2004, the court withdrew its opinion of January 29, 2004, and issued a new opinion to address concerns raised in the Appellants' motions for rehearing. On June 4, the Appellants filed a motion for extension of time to file a new motion for rehearing.
