

Dear Mr. Galloway:

Pursuant to P.U.C. Subst. R. §§ 25.93 and 25.71, NRG South Texas LP ("NRG South Texas") and NRG Texas LP ("NRG Texas") jointly submit two compact disks labeled "Confidential and Highly Sensitive Protected Material" and one labeled "Redacted Version" of their Third Quarter 2006 wholesale electricity transaction report.

The Third Quarter 2006 report presents information for both NRG South Texas and NRG Texas. Because all of NRG South Texas' generation is purchased by NRG Texas under a power purchase agreement, the NRG South Texas data is shown under NRG Texas' data.

NRG South Texas and NRG Texas hereby provide notice that they are providing Confidential and Highly Sensitive Protected Material in connection with the filing of each company's Third Quarter 2006 wholesale electric sales transactions pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 25.93. Specifically, NRG South Texas and NRG Texas consider identification of the counter-parties, the prices and quantities of electricity sold, and the total value of each transaction during the Third Quarter 2006 to be Confidential and Highly Sensitive Protected Material. This information is therefore being filed pursuant to the provisions of P.U.C. SUBST. R. 25.93(g) and P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.71(d).

Information pertaining to identification of the counter-party, both the prices and the quantities of electricity sold, and the total value of each transaction is competitively sensitive information, the release of which could disadvantage NRG South Texas and NRG Texas in



future wholesale transactions. As such, the information is to be protected from disclosure pursuant to the Tex. Util. Code Ann. §§39.001(b)(4) and 39.155(a). Moreover, such information is also excepted from the definition and scope of "public information" by the provisions of the Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §§ 552.101 (confidential information) and 552.110 (trade secrets and competitively sensitive commercial information).

If the Commission determines at some future date to release to third parties the information deemed confidential by NRG South Texas or NRG Texas, both NRG South Texas and NRG Texas request that actual notice in writing be provided to the following representatives at least three (3) business days prior to release of the information at issue:
