Pursuant to the requirements of Section 26.85, subsection (i) of the Substantive Rules Applicable to Telecommunications Providers, please note that Navigator does not have any employees in the State of Texas. The Company does, however, employ a highly diverse workforce at our North Little Rock office. As of September 30, 2005, 54% are Caucasian, 36% are African American, 7% are Hispanic, 1% is Asian and 2% are other. Currently, Navigator has one employee who maintains a residence in Texas but works out of our North Little Rock, AR headquarters. The Company continues to pursue nondiscriminatory hiring practices as our workforce expands.
