

Ladies and Gentlemen,

My name is Robert Milton, and I live on the corner of Farm Road 1495 and County Road 753, along with my wife and grandson. I have just recently found out that **the electric company has requested twice the amount of power** crossing next to me and my family. These KV LINES are going to injure us, please help. The lines will pass as close as 16 feet from my home on Farm Road 1495 and 20 feet to 40 feet and County Road 753. NOTE: There are other Routes - Route #3 is on the owners property. Hurts no one.

I would like to inform you of our medical problems. My wife has blood pressure problems and is in pain constantly along with numbness in her hands and feet, plus head aches. She has undergone many surgeries (2 on her neck, 3 on her back-plus fusion, 3 hip replacements, a shoulder repair and a shoulder replacement). My grandson has congenital heart disease. I have diabetes, high blood pressure, 3 stints in my heart. And my father died with a massive heart attack.

Our home is handicap friendly with a lift from ground floor to the 2nd floor. We have special bathtub, shower, commode and sinks. Our yard has a sprinkler system and we also have 16 sprinklers around the 2nd floor to water our flowers and shrubbery. We also have a great view of the Gulf of Mexico. My storage building is air conditioned. We have put our home up for sale and have had 3 buyers, but when we tell them about the lines, that ends any hope of selling. If you OK the electric company right of way, please insist that they purchase our home at market value, **as this home will have to be torn down (UNSAFE TO LIVE IN)**. We will have to purchase another home and then change the insides to accommodate our needs. I am 67 years old and it is a little late to start over again.
