- CR42-1 Please refer to RFP Schedule V-K-7 of the RFP, Bates 3122. For each of the 4 primary types of pass through expense, please provide by expense item
 - (a) the test year expense by FERC account;
 - (b) the amount requested by FERC account;
 - (c) references to other RFP schedules that clearly show how the expense is treated in the request and that the expense is not double counted; and
 - (d) the sponsoring witness and references to specific pages of testimony that discuss the expense.

- CR42-2 Please refer to RFP Schedule V-K-6, Bates 3117, line 5. Using RFP references, please show that the \$839,740 adjustment for the TDU employee transfers has not been double counted, i.e., show that the "existing cost" has been removed from the requested revenue requirement.
- CR42-3 Please refer to RFP Schedule V-K-6, Bates 3117, line 4, the \$1,380,980 adjustment for "competitive pay." Please
 - (a) provide the calculation with supporting details and documents by company;
 - (b) explain the "escalation of services" purpose; and
 - (c) provide other RFP references so that the total effect on revenue requirement is shown; and
 - (d) provide other RFP references to show the adjustment is not double counted.
- CR42-4 Please refer to RFP Schedule V-K-6 and provide the information on that schedule in RFP Schedule V-K-12 format.
- CR42-5 Please provide all information necessary to show that the Company has not included in this rate case any expenses related to the upfront qualified costs of issuing and servicing bonds related to stranded costs (Dockets 30706 and 32436), including but not limited to the related test year expense incurred by affiliate by FERC account and (b) references to RFP schedules and work papers that show the removal of the test year expense.
