On behalf of the local incumbent local exchange companies listed below (the ILECs), following is the response to PUC Staff's August 23, 2006 request for written descriptions of utilities' vegetation management programs for overhead facilities, and on-going cyclical, ground-based inspection programs for overhead facilities.

Solutions<sup>\*\*</sup>

Over 95% of the ILECs' facilities are underground, therefore no formal vegetation management or ground-based inspection programs for overhead facilities currently are in place, because they are unnecessary. The ILECs provide very little aerial facilities. If aerial facilities do exist, they are usually attached to poles belonging to other utilities and the applicable pole attachment agreement governs pole maintenance.
