



Dear Coastal Coordination Council Secretary:

As required by Section 505.30(e) of the Texas Coastal Management Program and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 25.102, the Commission's records indicate that for the 1st Quarter period of September 1, 2018 through November 30, 2018, seven applications for certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) involving a transmission line or generation facilities were filed. The Commission approved a total of six applications for transmission facilities in the 1st quarter of FY 2019, none of which were subject to CMP oversight. There are three dockets currently pending that are subject to CMP oversight.
