WHEREAS, the financial integrity of the state's regulated utilities is essential to constructing and maintaining the electric system infrastructure essential for Texas' continued economic growth; and


WHEREAS, quality electric delivery service at reasonable prices is an essential part of making economic growth and increased employment opportunities possible; and

WHEREAS, quality electrical delivery service at reasonable prices is an essential component contributing to economic growth and making increased business and employment opportunities possible; and


