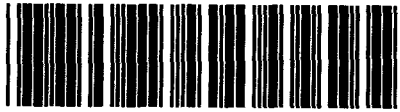

**SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE (08-09-07)**

**REQUEST:**

What will be the powers and duties of the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board?  
Please provide all articles of incorporation, bylaws, or other documents that relate to the powers and duties of the Board.

**SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE:**

The following supplemental response was prepared by or under the direct supervision of Frederick Goltz, the sponsoring witness for this response.

Pursuant to ALJ Order No. 14, Oncor is supplementing this response with information previously withheld on the basis of its objection. Oncor continues to maintain its objection and does not intend to waive that objection by virtue of this production.

TEF has committed to create an independent Sustainable Energy Advisory Board (SEAB) comprised of individuals who represent the following interests: (i) environmental, (ii) TXU customers, (iii) Texas economic development, and (iv) ERCOT reliability standards. The SEAB will include representatives from Environmental Defense and the Natural Resources Defense Council. At this point, the specific powers and duties of the SEAB have not been finalized, nor have articles of incorporation or bylaws been drafted.

In general, the SEAB will work with TXU to make climate stewardship central to TXU's corporate policies. For example, TXU has started the planning process for two integrated gasification combined cycle (IGCC) commercial demonstration plants, and in connection with this plan, TXU will issue a request for proposal (RFP) from companies offering coal gasification technologies. The SEAB will review these proposals and advise TXU regarding its views of the proposals. The SEAB may also assist TXU to evaluate new technologies designed to improve TXU's environmental retrofit program and to help reduce key emissions of SO<sub>x</sub>, NO<sub>x</sub>, and mercury. In addition, the SEAB will work with TXU Energy and TXU's proposed Low Income Advisory Committee, which will be comprised of leaders in the social service delivery sector, to identify the best and most effective ways to spend funding designated for low-income aid and to explore the creation of a foundation to assist in these efforts.
