Dear Sir or Madam:

The City of Baytown is in receipt of a notification letter concerning the above-referenced application of Kelson Transmission. Please be advised that the City of Baytown adamantly opposes the transmission line crossing property owned by the City, proposed to be developed as a fire station, and the subject of a called November 2007 bond election. For years, the City has been planning to construct this fire station in order to better and more efficiently protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens in the area. For such planning and goal to be thwarted by Kelson Transmission's proposed route for its transmission line is both unacceptable and unconscionable. The proposed routing not only renders the City's property virtually valueless but also is contrary to the City's compelling governmental interest in the protection of its citizens, which clearly outweighs whatever interest Kelson Transmission may have in the construction of its line on the City's property.

As such, enclosed please find a Request to Intervene in PUC Docket No. 34611 concerning Kelson Transmission's application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for a proposed substation and transmission line in Chambers, Hardin, Jasper, Jefferson, Liberty, Newton and Orange Counties. Please be advised that the City of Baytown stands ready to assist Kelson Transmission in achieving its goal but cannot accept its line traversing property so instrumental in the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Baytown.
