## RESPONSE OF TEXAS LEGAL SERVICES CENTER AND TEXAS RATEPAYERS' ORGANIZATION TO SAVE ENERGY TO EGSI'S MOTION FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF NUS TARIFF

NOW COME Texas Legal Services Center (TLSC) and Texas Ratepayers' Organization to Save Energy (Texas ROSE) and file this Response to EGSI's Motion for Review and Approval of NUS Tariff, pursuant to Order No. 45.

TLSC and Texas ROSE are currently in talks with EGSI to seek clarification on a number of issues affecting low-income customers with regards to the proposed NUS tariff. However, because of the short response period set forth in Order No. 45, the parties have not had adequate time to be able to resolve these issues. Therefore, insofar as there may be a need to either file an amendment to the proposed tariff or for TLSC and Texas ROSE (or other parties) to file a response to the tariff, TLSC and Texas ROSE respectfully request that the parties be given the ten days to respond to the proposed tariff as originally requested by EGSI. Counsel for TLSC and Texas ROSE have conferred with counsel for the Office of Public Utility Counsel ("OPC") and can represent that OPC also supports the ten day response period requested by EGSI.

TLSC and Texas ROSE would also respectfully request that the ALJs not rule on EGSI's motion or on the joint response filed by Commission Staff and other parties opposed to the NUS until after the response period.
