## FORM OF IRREVOCABLE STANDBY LETTER OF CREDIT

This Letter of Credit shall be governed by the Uniform Customs and Practice for Documentary Credits, 2007 Revision, International Chamber of Commerce Publication No. 600 (the "UCP"), except to the extent that the terms hereof are inconsistent with the provisions of the UCP, including but not limited to Articles 14(b) and 36 of the UCP, in which case the terms of this Letter of Credit shall govern. It is a condition of this Letter of Credit that it will be automatically extended without amendment for one year from the expiration date hereof, or any future expiration date, unless at least 90 days prior to any expiration date we notify you at the above address by registered mail or

hand delivered courier that we elect not to consider this Letter of Credit renewed for any such period.
