“My name is Selena Gonzales. I am an employee of the Lower Colorado River Authority. I am over twenty-one years of age and I am competent to make this Affidavit. I have personal knowledge of the facts contained herein and they are true and correct.

In accordance with P.U.C. Proc. Rule 25.83 on April 14, 2009 LCRA Transmission Services Corporation completed a search for and mailed notice to:

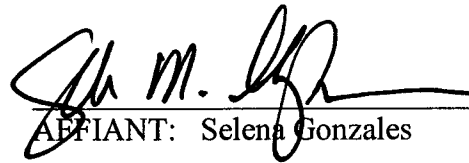
- (a) owners of land crossed by the existing transmission facilities to be modified, T-424 Red Creek to Comanche
- (b) owners of land crossed by the existing transmission facilities to be modified, T-185 Zorn to Lytton Springs
- (c) owners of land crossed by the existing transmission facilities to be modified, T-216 Fayetteville to Bellville South

In accordance with P.U.C. Proc. Rule 25.83, on April 14, 2009 LCRA Transmission Services Corporation completed a search for and mailed notice to:

- (d) Cap Rock Energy Corporation and AEP Texas whose certified electric territories are crossed by the existing transmission facilities to be modified, T-424 Red Creek to Comanche
- (e) Bluebonnet Electric Cooperative, Pedernales Electric Cooperative, Guadalupe Valley Electric Cooperative and Austin Energy whose certified electric territories are crossed by the existing transmission facilities to be modified, T-185 Zorn to Lytton Springs
- (f) Bluebonnet Electric Cooperative and San Bernard Electric Cooperative, whose certified electric territories are crossed by the existing transmission facilities to be modified, T-216 Fayetteville to Bellville South.

The search for the names of the landowners whose property is crossed by the modified electric transmission facilities as described in (a,b,c) above, was ascertained by reference to available aerial photography, available maps, and title records at the McCulloch, Caldwell, Fayette, Colorado and Austin county courthouses and the current McCulloch, Caldwell, Fayette, Colorado and Austin county tax rolls. The certificated utilities described in (d,e,f) above, were ascertained by reference to Public Utility Commission's Certified Electric Service Area Boundary Maps and other available maps.
