On behalf of Southwest Texas Telephone Company (“Southwest Texas” or “the Company”), please find enclosed an Affidavit attesting that the Company has updated its Emergency Operations Plan (“EOP”) pursuant to 16 TAC § 26.51.

The Company is also filing electronically a copy of the updated EOP confidentially as it contains proprietary and operationally sensitive information. Therefore, Southwest Texas is requesting confidential treatment of its EOP in accordance with the procedures identified in PUC Proc. R. § 22.71(d).

Southwest Texas’ EOP does not contain a hurricane plan because it does not provide service in the counties designated within the hurricane evacuation zone, as defined by the Governor’s Division of Emergency Management.

This revised EOP replaces the EOP filed previously.

5. The matters addressed above are within my personal knowledge and are true and correct.

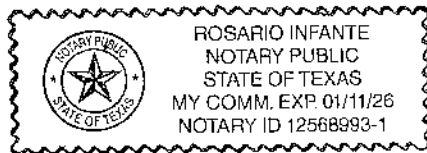
