SUPPORTING THE LANDOWNERS PRESERVATION GROUP
AND OPPOSING ROUTE GN6

TO THE HONORABLE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

The communities in Buchanan Dam (Buchanan Dam Communities), represented by the undersigned homeowner associations' leadership and the Cassie Volunteer Fire Department, hereby give notice to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) of their support of the positions taken by the Landowners Preservation Group (LPG) in the above-captioned proceeding. Specifically, the Buchanan Dam Communities support the adoption of Route GN5 for the reasons the LPG provides in its post-hearing briefs, Exceptions to the Proposal for Decision and Replies to Exceptions.

The Buchanan Dam Communities oppose the adoption of Route GN6 and any route that would cut through Buchanan Dam for the following reasons:

- GN6 would cross State Highway 29, the main commercial street in Buchanan Dam, three times;
- GN6 would destroy the recreational enjoyment of Lake Buchanan, Inks Lake and Inks Lake State Park that attract tourists and support the Buchanan Dam Communities' economy;
 - GN6 would destroy the aesthetics associated with the Lake

Buchanan and Inks Lake, two highland lakes, also hurting the Buchanan Dam Communities tourism industry;

- GN6 would destroy uninterrupted lake views, reducing property values and hurting development of numerous existing subdivisions, such as the Cliffs at Waters Ridge and Grand Sabana;
- GN6 would cross through a mobile home park and come within less than 100 feet of 22 homes and businesses;
- GN6 would come within 140 feet of the Genesis Lutheran Church;


