TO PUC COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST SET OF REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION TO LCRA TRANSMISSION SERVICES CORPORATION.

BA-1-1 Do you have a habitable structure near one or more of the links of the proposed transmission Line? If so, describe the structure, identify the link(s) and estimate how far the proposed line is From the habitable structure?

Response:

Yes – approximately 300-500' from "The Pub".

However there is a residential habitat on the other side of the fence that would probably come within' a 100' of link C-17. There is also a road on this land

that isn't paved but is used to navigate around on which would be directly under the lines affecting the well being of people.
