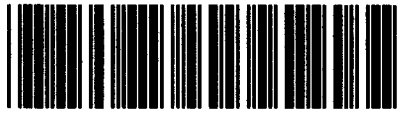

We strongly support the preferred route as it misses heavy population of small land owners (including ours!) smaller tracts would suffer greater percentage depreciation.  
Imagine our small (189 acre tract), already divided by a railroad track, then again divided by a large LORA transmission line. And then divided again by this project if alternate route chosen. The 160' strip through our sparse wooded area would destroy the property's deer lease value permanently. It is a major source of income, as the poor soil will only support ten cattle.
