Dear Judge Pomerleau and Judge Pratibha J. Shenoy:

- 1. I am a small land owner representing myself in this case. <u>I do not want my property destroyed on Route A between Roby and Anson</u>. If Lone Star transmissions had of designed Route A by extending Route D to where the intersection of Route A, Route H and Route G merge then the Texas Electric Transmission line of 345 KV placed on my property in 1981 could have been used. But Lone Star Transmission chose completely new land and destroying our living area for this land where the old home site was built in early 1900 and over the old well.
- 2. Route A as designed by Lone Star Transmission will destroy Very Good Land for growing food as proven from 1900 to present day. It is not right to destroy good farm land which may some day be the only source of food for those that live in the area.
- 3. Route A will destroy College and University Research on <u>Rolling Plains Quall Research Ranch 12 miles West of Roby.</u>
  People interested in Quail and Other endangered animals paid lots of money for the land and research needs protection from Big Power Lines.
- 4. I do not think PUC selected the correct Route A and I believe Lone Star Transmission Power Line Designers spent more time and effort analyzing all legal phases in Selection Route C and therefore the route that parallels other Power Lines should be selected.
- 5. In 1900 Power Lines Could be built straight. Today the land owners who have lots of money should not be given priority over small land owners. All Land Owners Love their Land whether one acre or 1000 acres please look at our desires to keep our family history from being destroyed.

I do not understand the logic for cutting across land in a diagonal and destroying my land with a completely new transmission line. Also my entrance road for property will be destroyed.

Other land owners in Fisher County area have small plots of ground and the NEW Lone Star Transmission lines will destroy our useage of our property.
