Based on the post-PFD briefing, it does not appear that any parties on the Central A to Central C portion of the case are advocating a route that would include Link F, which would have crossed and substantially interfered with United States Gypsum Company's (USGC's) quarry in Nolan County, Texas. Accordingly, USGC will not be filing replies to exceptions to the proposal for decision (PFD) in the above-referenced matter.
