QUESTION

Please provide a detailed explanation, including any supporting documents, as to why the road labeled by Lone Star on Figure 17-1 (County Map), Sheet 5 of 13, as "CR 104" has been labeled as such. Please include in your explanation why such road is considered a "county road" versus a private ranch road.

RESPONSE

The data used to determine road names and ownership (public vs. private) was digital data obtained from the Texas Natural Resources Information System (TNRIS) Strategic Mapping Program, which produces, maintains, and enhances statewide digital geographic data. All of the roads labeled CR 104 on Figure 17-1, Sheet 5 are shown in the TNRIS data as CR 104. Roads which were labeled in the data as private or unnamed were not shown on the Figure 17-1 maps.
