**NOTICE OF FILING FOR ENFORCEMENT OF COMMISSION ORDER**

<p>Notice is given to the public of a request filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas on September 17, 2010 for enforcement of Commission Order and request to close proceeding.

<p>Docket Style and Number: Filing Of Luminant Generation Company LLC to Establish Date to Transfer Electric Service in Compliance with Docket Number 30037, Docket Number 38275.

<p>The Application: Rusk County Electric Cooperative (Rusk County) filed a request with the Commission for enforcement of Commission Order and request to close proceeding. Rusk County alleges that Luminant Generation Company, LLC (Luminant) has failed to comply with the Commission's Order in Docket Number 30037.

<p>The Commission's Order on Rehearing in Docket Number 30037, affirmed the Commission's findings that Luminant Generation is in violation of Public Utility Regulatory Act <\*>31.002(10) when it provides electric service to Luminant Mining. Ordering Paragraph Number 3 ordered Luminant to file within 30 days of the date of the order a detailed plan describing the manner and timing of transferring the retail electric service for the Beckville-Tatum mining load over to Rusk County. The instant proceeding, Docket Number 38275, was established for the filing of this plan and the eventual termination of the Rusk County complaint proceedings. Rusk County requests that the Commission find that the parties are in disagreement, and that the Commission should terminate this proceeding and require Luminant Generation, by a date certain, to transfer electric service and to cease the illegal provision of retail electric service to Luminant Mining Company.
