XV. PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

A. Findings of Fact

On December 20, 2010, Commission Staff filed its Exceptions (to the proposal for decision). As part of its Exceptions, Staff included a proposed revised finding of fact regarding ROE that included a typo. Staff filed the following:

73. A 10.41 ~~67~~ percent ROE is consistent with CenterPoint's business and regulatory risk.

However, Staff's intention was to file the following proposed revised FOF:

73. A ~~10.41~~9.67 percent ROE is consistent with CenterPoint's business and regulatory risk.




