We are directly affected landowners in PUC Docket No. 38354. Our property is affected by Line Segment 03 on some alternate routes from McOmey to Kendall (MK), and by Line Segment A4 on some alternate routes from Kendall to Gillespie (KG). WE OPPOSE any route that includes either 03 or A4.

We strongly SUPPORT the preferred route selected by LCRA from Kendall to Gillespie due to the significant amount of existing Right of Way it utilizes, especially along Line Segment A3. While we also support the preferred route selected by LCRA from McOmey to Kendall, we would encourage the Commission to utilize the path of existing transmission lines in any alternate routes, including the private line operated by NextEra Energy.
