We strongly SIFKAT the preferred route selected by ICRA from Kendall to Gillespie due to the significant amount of existing Right of Way it utilizes, especially along Line Segment A3. While we also support the preferred route selected by LOWA from McCamey to Kerdall, we would encourage the Commission to utilize the path of existing transmission lines in any alternate routes, including the private line operated by Next Eta Energy.
