**ORDER NO. 1
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND
FILING AND SERVICE PROCEDURES**

On July 9, 2010, Universal Cable Holdings, Inc., d/b/a Suddenlink Communications (the Applicant) filed an application under § 66.003 of the Public Utility Regulatory Act, TEX. UTIL. CODE ANN. (Vernon 2007 & Supp. 2009) (PURA) for approval to amend its State-Issued Certificate of Franchise Authority (SICFA) No. 90025. Applicant is seeking to expand its service area footprint to include Monahans, Texas. An announcement of the application will be published in the *Texas Register* according to the procedural schedule below. A copy of the announcement will be filed in this project. Commission Staff shall file a recommendation regarding the sufficiency and completeness of the application no later than **July 23, 2010**. This case has been assigned **Project No. 38437** by the Commission. All documents filed in this case shall use this project number.

I. Filing and Service Procedures

A. Filing

Seven (7) copies of all filings are required. Documents shall be deemed filed when the proper number of legible copies is presented to the Commission's Filing Clerk for filing. The procedures regarding filing specified in Subchapter E of the Commission's procedural rules apply in this proceeding, unless otherwise specified.

B. Service

A copy of any document filed with the Commission must also be served in accordance with P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.74(a). Methods of service must comply with P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.74(b) and evidence of service with P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.74(c).

C. Filing Deadline Procedures

Filings at the Commission shall occur by 3:00 p.m. on the due date unless otherwise specified. P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.71(i).
