Notice of Withdrawal of Intervention and Submission in Lien of Intervention of Protest Comment Against Links Z9, H1512, H152, H19, and H2 which Cross Through the Scenic, Old Growth Forest, and High Habitable Structure Area Known as Cross Timbers

I, the undersigned, hereby withdraw my intervention in this case, not because I no longer oppose an Oncor transmission line impacting my property and the Cross Timbers communities, but because I am not able to continue to proceed as a "party" in the face of the discovery and other burdens being imposed upon me just to tell my concerns to the Commission. As a result of this withdrawal of intervention there will be no responses to any pending discovery requests.

In lieu of an intervention as a "party," I request that this notice and my prior filings be considered as a protest comment in opposition to routes with Links Z9, H1512, H152, H19, and H2, because of proximity of the line, EMF health risk concerns, adverse aesthetic impacts, diminution of property values, interference with future property usage plans, adverse impacts on Aubrey Independent School District tax revenues, adverse impacts on the Cross Timbers Girl Scout camp, potential noise disturbance, placement of the line further inside the property and away from the property line, environmental concerns about going through the Cross Timbers region with removal of old growth trees, prudent avoidance concerns by going through "bedroom communities" of Quall Run and Red Oaks and other areas which bring numerous of habitable structures near the line; community value concerns by going through the scenic Cross Timbers region that is known as "Horse Country USA". The special sandy soil is ideal for raising and working horses (which results in more desirable and thus higher priced land).
