

Our family lives in a neighborhood on the Z8 link, across the street from the Greenbelt Park. We will have the H structures that tower 150 ft. with the same high voltage that will be coming through the widest part of the Greenbelt Park. Our entire neighborhood is full of young children and will be outlined with these high voltage towers and lines. Z8 is a highly populated, highly valued property segment (40-50,000 acre) as opposed to the more viable northern routes that were chosen in the original study area. We moved here because of the Greenbelt and were promised it would always remain in its present scenic and natural state. With so many more viable routes and so much rural land north of us, it doesn't make sense to follow this southern route and devastate so many homes in such a populated area as well as destroying the widest part of the Greenbelt Park. Please go back to the original study area and choose one of the original routes that make more sense.
