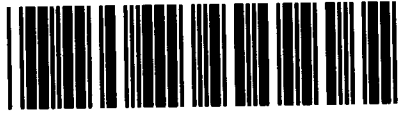

I am requesting to intervene in this proceeding. As an INTERVENOR, I understand the following:



In addition to the comments on page one, it is my strong belief that the construction of the proposed power line will negatively impact the real estate value of my property (segment: G21, Tract: 3210) and any surrounding property. The Clear Creek Watershed, in which my property is located, is a largely clay type soil with water run off having an impact on Lake Lewisville. Any additional clear cutting of right of way would certainly have a negative impact on the lake and it's users. The preferred route as indicated by Oncor would effect a far less number of property owners and best utilize existing easements already in place. If the power line must be built in Denton County, the route preferred by Oncor in their filing certainly would be the wisest choice.
