



### Procedural History

On May 8, 2006, the Commission granted Utilities Savings Services, LLC (Utilities Savings) Aggregation Registration No. 80227. On September 29, 2010, Utilities Savings filed an application to withdraw its aggregator registration pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST R. 25.111(i)(10).

### Recommendation

Staff of the Infrastructure and Reliability Division has reviewed the application of Utilities Savings. A review of Utilities Savings' initial application for aggregator registration indicates that Utilities Savings was not registered to collect customer pre-payments; thus, it has not collected any advance payments from aggregation customers. Additionally, the applicant indicated that it has never provided aggregations services. Based on the aforementioned, Staff recommends approval of Utilities Savings' application to withdraw as an aggregator.
