**ORDER NO. 2
NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**

On January 7, 2011, Texas Windstream, Inc., Valor Telecommunications of Texas, LP d/b/a Windstream Communications Southwest, Windstream Communications Kerrville, LP, and Windstream Sugar Land, Inc. (collectively, Windstream), and Time Warner Cable Information Services (Texas), LLC d/b/a Time Warner Cable (TWCIS) (collectively, Applicants) filed a joint application for approval of an interconnection agreement (Agreement) under the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996¹ and the Public Utility Regulatory Act.² The joint application included a copy of the Agreement.

The Agreement meets the requirements of P.U.C. PROC. R. 21.97; therefore, this joint application is approved effective the date this Order is signed. TWCIS shall not provide service in any geographic areas or under any name not authorized by its Commission-granted SPCOA.

Applicants shall file two complete interconnection agreements, one unbound, within 15 working days of the date this Order is signed, if not previously filed. The copies shall be clearly marked with the control number assigned to the proceeding and the language "Complete



interconnection agreement as approved [or modified and approved] on [insert date].” Also, within 15 working days of the approval of the agreement, the incumbent local exchange company (ILEC) shall post notice of the approved interconnection agreement on its website in a separate, easily identifiable area of the website. The ILEC website shall provide a complete list of approved interconnection agreements, listed alphabetically by carrier, including docket numbers and effective dates. In addition, the ILEC website shall provide a direct link to the Commission’s website.
