DISMISSING COMPLAINT

On April 6, 2011, Rico Richardson (Complainant) filed a formal complaint against Oncor Electric Delivery Company, LLC (Oncor) regarding meter tampering. The complaint was docketed as a formal complaint in accordance with P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.242.

On April 29, 2011, Oncor filed a response to the complaint. Oncor argued that the complaint should be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction because the property subject to this complaint is located within the corporate boundaries of DeSoto Texas and the City of DeSoto has not ceded original jurisdiction to the Commission; or because Oncor's actions were consistent with Sections 6.1.2.1 and 4.7.5 of its approved tariff and the Commission's substantive rules.

On May 6, 2011, Commission Staff filed a statement of position. Commission Staff confirmed that on February 15, 2011, Complainant filed an informal complaint with the Customer Protection Division of the Commission. Complainant was subsequently notified on March 9 and 29, 2011, that the Customer Protection Division was unable to resolve the dispute to his satisfaction. Commission Staff recommended dismissal of this docket because Complainant's service address is within the corporate boundaries of DeSoto Texas and the City of DeSoto has not ceded original jurisdiction to the Commission.

Based upon the foregoing, the complaint against Oncor is dismissed, without prejudice, pursuant to P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.181(a)(1)(A).
