NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR WAIVER FROM REQUIREMENTS IN USAUTOMATIC DIAL ANNOUNCING DEVICES (ADAD) APPLICATION FORM

Notice is given to the public of an application filed on November 1, 2014, which Public Utility Commission of Texas (commission) for waiver from the requirements in the commission prescribed application for a permit to operate automatic dial announcing devices.

Docket Style and Number: Request of Five9, Inc. for an Exception to the Federal Registration Number Requirement of the ADAD Application Form, Docket Number 39883.

The Application: Five9, Inc. filed a request for a waiver of the registration number requirement, in the Public Utility Commission of Texas prescribed application for a permit to operate automatic dial announcing devices (ADAD). Specifically, Question 11(e) of the application requires the Federal Registration Number (FRN) issued to the ADAD manufacturer or programmer either by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) or Administrative Council Terminal Attachments (ACTA).

Five9 stated that it places calls using a Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) platform and is exempt from FCC registration requirements under Part 68. Ordinarily, Part 68 of the FCC's rules requires registration of terminal equipment connected to the telephone network.
